## FATALITIES

211 electrical workers were among 3500 construction site fatalities investigated by OSHA from 1985 through 1989. Remember the stuff you are working with is killing you. 60% of all electrical employees who died were electrocuted. Falls are cited for 17% of the deaths. Voltage greater than 480 V accounted for 74% of the fatalities.

Out of those who died from electric shock, 95% of the deaths occurred when the worker contacted live parts. The remainder of the deaths were associated with ungrounded tools. The size of the electrical contracting firm and the worker's ages also made no difference in the number of employees killed.
