## Fake-ID Users Risk Losing Their Real Ones

Beginning Tuesday, underage drinkers caught using a fake ID to purchase alcohol will lose one of the most prized possessions of adolescence: a driver's license. Until this week, Teenagers caught with a fake license would simply lose the fake license. But under new state law, when someone is caught with a fake ID, police will issue a citation. For a first offense, the MVA will suspend the person's actual driver's license for six months. On a second offense, the license will be suspended until the violator turns 21, no matter how long that is. In Prince George's County, inspectors will begin this month to enforce the new state law by citing and helping prosecute people under 21 caught with phony ID's.
