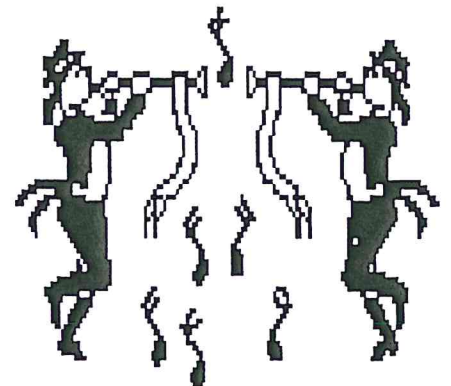
MISCELLANEOUS
