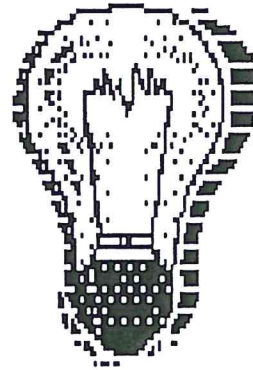

FASCINATING FACT

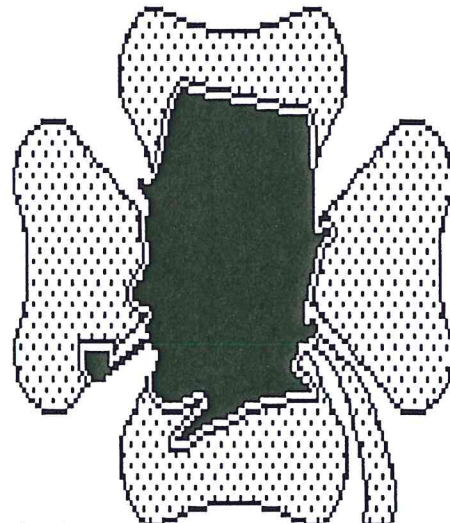
